Ask Carl

Q: RHGC fees seemed to go up a lot this year. I don't remember voting on this.

A: More of a statement than a question but I see where you're going with this. Regular members do not vote on what the annual RHGC dues are. As per the RHGC Constitution, Section IV-3-2, the dues are set by the Board of Directors. I'm paraphrasing here but you can look it up on the RHGC Website. The last time RHGC increased dues was four years ago in 2015. Dues went from 600 SAR to 800 SAR. This was to offset the cost of ForeTees and USGA Membership. So why are fees increasing again? Prices of items and the cost of getting items to KSA have increased significantly. Things like VAT and shipping have really hurt us. You may have noticed in the past year there were not as many tournaments where there was swag like shirts, hats, lunches, etc... We had to scale back on such items in order to stay under budget. However, we have heard from our membership, and from Saudi Aramco upper management, that those items are appreciated and wanted. Therefore, to cover the costs of these items, dues have increased.
