The next "Golf in a Week" class starts on March 24th. Classes are an hour each day beginning at 7:00 pm and run for 5 consecutive days. Courses aimed at beginner and intermediate golfers. It covers all aspects of the game: Safety, Rules, Etiquette, Swing Method, and an on course Texas scramble. All equipment and range balls are supplied. The cost is 600 SAR. Please sign up in the Pro Shop.

Ask Carl

- Q: I play in a lot of RHGC tournaments, and almost every medal. How come when I look at My GHIN account I only see a couple of rounds with a T beside them?
- A: I don't know which is more impressive, that you examine your GHIN scores or the amount of tournaments that you play! But you are correct, there are only 5 T-scores (tournament score a score made in a competition organized and conducted by the Committee in charge of the competition) taken into account for your handicap. This was at the Texas Golf Association's suggestion. TGA suggested we have less T's because if you have too many the R reduction never kicks in. We chose the CEO Cup, the May Monthly Medal, the Club Championship (both days), and the November Monthly Medal.

Terms and Conditions

*In order to be eligible to play in the Grand Finals, the winner must have an active handicap and must have completed THREE Handicap Qualifying Scores (as defined by the relevant handicap governing body) within the 12 months prior to the date of the qualifying event.

In order to be eligible to progress through to the Grand Final, players must be aged 21 or over on the day of the qualifying tournament.

Please also note that any player who has previously qualified for any Grand Final of the Turkish Airlines World Golf Cup Amateur Series (in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 or 2018) will not be eligible to progress to the 2019 Grand Finals.

**The Grand Finals package is correct at the time of publication.
