From the Pro

Stuart will be running the next "Golf in a Week" class starting on January 22nd. Classes are an hour each day beginning at 7:00 pm. This is a 5 consecutive day course aimed at beginner and intermediate golfers. It covers all aspects of the game: Safety, Rules, Etiquette, Swing Method, and an on course Texas scramble. The cost is 600 SAR per person.

Also, a Junior Tour School will commence on January 11th and will last for 5 weeks. The clinic will cover the fundamentals and basics (putting, irons, chipping, and woods) of the game and swing. Only children aged 8 – 16 are permitted to take part in a Junior Clinic. The class runs for one hour each Wednesday from 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm. The cost is 400 SAR and needs to be paid in cash to Stuart.

A Ladies only class runs each Thursday morning from 9-10 AM. All equipment is supplied and there is free coffee on arrival. It is ideal for either the beginner or intermediate golfer as it covers all the skills to get one out on the course! The cost is 90 SAR per person per class.

Upcoming Tournament Information

Ask Carl

Q: How come the RHGC elections were just held but it was for only 3 positions? Aren't there like 15 Board members?

A: There are actually 14 Board members. There are the Board Executive members: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Tournament Director, Handicap Director, and Secretary. Each of the Executive Board members serve a 2 year term. The election for Board Executive positions are divided into groups in order to ensure a smooth transition between Board members. Board Executive members are not allowed to run for consecutive Board Executive positions. Apart from the Board Executive, there are 8 yearly appointed Board members: Membership Director, Youth Golf Director, Pro Shop Director, Grounds and Rules Director, Clubhouse Director, Ladies Golf Director, Social Director, and Media Director. Appointed Board members are selected each January by the RHGC Board Executive. If you are interested, please submit your name to our President Dave Minchau.

Q: How should I leave the rake when I'm done using it in a bunker?

A: First off, congratulations on knowing that one is supposed to rake a bunker after you are done hitting your ball out of it. We need more people like you playing our course. While there is no rule, there is a miscellaneous decision in both the USGA and R&A rule book (M-2/2). The decision states that it is recommended that rakes should be left outside bunkers in areas where they are least likely to affect the movement of the ball. Note the word recommended—it is not a rule but a suggestion. In the end, it is up to each club to decide where it wants rakes to be placed. At RHGC, we just want rakes to be used.


Membership Survey

In November of 2016 the RHGC sent a survey to its membership. The following is a summary of the results of the survey.


To what extent do you feel you get value for money for your RHGC membership fees?




How easy is it to book a tee time when you want one?



Please tell us what you think about the number of golf tournaments?




Please tell us what you think about the type of golf tournaments?





How do you enter scores for handicap purposes?




How satisfied are you with the Proshop.

Please tell us what you think about the Club House and snack services.



Grounds & Rules

As of December 29th, 2016, there is a local rule in effect permitting preferred lies on the fairway until further notice.

This local rule allows players to mark, lift, clean, and place a ball on any closely mowed area of the course. This does not include the rough. Additionally, once a ball has been placed, it cannot be lifted and replaced.

Cart Shed Update

In 2017, RHGC hopes to assign the 108 cart sheds that are currently under construction.

In order for current members to retain their position on the Golf Cart Shed Waiting List, or as a new member to be added, one must meet the following criteria:

- RHGC membership must be paid by January 31st, 2017
- Annual Green Fees must be arranged by January 31st, 2017

Please note that if current members on the Golf Cart Shed Waiting List fail to meet the above criteria, they will be removed from the list.

Current Golf Cart Shed holders must fulfill all of the following requirements to retain their cart shed status:

- RHGC membership must be paid by January 31st, 2017
- Annual Green Fees must be arranged by January 31st, 2017
- Golf Cart Shed Rental Fee must be paid by January 31st, 2017
- 2017 Golf Cart Shed Form must be completed and signed

Please note that failure to meet all of the above requirements will mean loss of your cart shed.
