The next "Golf in a Week" class starts on December 16th. Classes are an hour each day beginning at 7:00 pm and run for 5 consecutive days. Courses aimed at beginner and intermediate golfers. It covers all aspects of the game: Safety, Rules, Etiquette, Swing Method, and an on course Texas scramble. All equipment and range balls are supplied. The cost is 600 SAR. Golf Ball Tournament

In conjunction with the Golf Ball in Bahrain, the annual Golf Ball Tournament will take place at the Royal Golf Club in Riffa on **December 7th**. The format for the Tournament is a Shamble. All four golfers tee off, the best ball is selected, and all golfers play from that spot. However, from the 3rd shot on, all golfers play their own ball. Fee to play is 550 SAR and should be paid in the ProShop.

Starting in 2019 you will need to take the Handicap Quiz (and pass with 80%) to be eligible to play in tournaments. An accurate Handicap Index is key in creating a level playing field for tournament play, giving everyone a fair chance to be competitive. Hopefully the Quiz will give everyone some general knowledge about the USGA Handicap System and a better understanding of how their Handicap Index relates to their actual scores.

Ground & Rules

The Tamarix removal is Continuing. The plan is to have all removed by October 2019. The removal has brought up some questions regarding relief. This was addressed in the April edition of the RHGC newsletter. Below you will find a recap of the relief rules.

Until we are finished with the Tamarix removal, we will regard all debris piles as immovable obstructions and Rule 24-2 "Immovable Obstruction" will apply. If you hit your ball into a debris pile (branches or other immovable obstructions) you are entitled to a free drop under Rule 24-2. You can drop your ball within 1 club length and no nearer to the hole.

If you want to consider the debris as a movable obstruction then Rule 24-1 "Movable Obstruction" can be applied. In this case you can lift your ball, move the debris, and then drop your ball at the same location with no penalty. Use your discretion and in general we don't want players hoisting branches and debris around so Rule 24-2 should be applied liberally until the Tamarix removal has been completed.

If you hit your ball into a debris pile that is in the water, play as normal, and you are not entitled to a free drop.

If you are in the dirt and your ball is resting in a tire track, this is considered "rub of the green" and you must play your ball as it lies.

2019 Membership Drive

If you were not able to attend either of RHGC's Membership Drive events, you can still renew your membership. Instructions, and forms, on how to do so can be found on the <u>RHGC</u> <u>Website</u>.

Leaving Saudi Aramco sometime in 2019? Remember that RHGC membership fees are nonrefundable. However, unused portions of green fees can be refunded by Recreation upon leaving Saudi Aramco. Additionally, if you have a cart shed, you must return the key prior to your departure.

Secondary Draw
