 - (Jeff) We have 3 Admins Kurt (for handicap purposes); Mel (for Membership purposes) and myself (Tournament Director). Rather than expanding Admin access, I can set up Event Managers for each event who can provide information quicker.

Making our own groups prevents anyone from expanding themselves to meet others in the club and reinforces cultural cliques." I agree with those comments and I also think 1) a lot of rules are broken because in some groups no one knows the rules and if you always play in the same group then no one learns the correct rules either, 2) scores tend to be lower because no one really checks the player he is marking because they're all friends.
