

Propose this policy to be communicated to all members:

"Whoever books a tee time shall own the tee time until 48 hours prior to teeing off. The owner has the right to make player changes on the tee time up to 48 hours prior to teeing off. When less than 48 hours to teeing off everyone has the right to join the tee time, if slot(s) are available, and the owner cannot drop someone without their permission."

## Course Update 5/12/219

Excerpts from course update discussion

- 1. Green complexes
  - Make bigger, different mowing patterns, etc.
  - If we like it, we can continue, or grow back out if not.
  - This is a good time to do this, including aeration, etc.
  - Mostly positive feedback from members
  - Open for suggestions
- 2. Fairways
  - Lines used for how mowing done
  - In Spring, cut down and aerate for optimal growth
- 3. New equipment
  - New equipment coming in September
  - We will have more frequent mowing
- 4. Landscaping & Planting
  - Still working on timeline, plan
  - Tamarisk removal, making good progress
  - Architect is working on plan hole by hole
- 5. Bunkers
  - All being altered, and have been poorly designed
  - Sand is very inconsistent texture and depth we want to change that
- 6. Primo
  - Chemical just came IK with Jeddah new golf course
  - Will help a lot with greens & grass growth
  - 20 gallons would handle RHGC
  - Jason will send Ed Devlin details of chemicals needed, as Ed has member contacts in Supply Chain who can follow-up
- 7. Penalty areas
  - Should be hazards golfers should be penalized
  - We are looking into different features, e.g. gravel, desert, etc. which would not allow hitting out of it, but players cold still find ball. Several holes that was the original course design (e.g. 16<sup>th</sup> green, 3<sup>rd</sup> fairway, etc.)
- 8. Course closure May 19-21
  - Course will be closed May 19 through 21 for course maintenance (e.g. aeration of greens, sanding, etc.)
