

Entering Scores

For those participating in the handicap program with a GHIN Number, **please don't forget to post all acceptable scores before midnight local time on the day of play.** You can enter scores in GHIN in two ways:

- GHIN mobile app (Installing the GHIN mobile app on your phone is recommended and is most convenient)
- GHIN website <http://www.ghin.com>

If you are having issues with GHIN, you can email your gross score by hole to rhgchandicaps@gmail.com. See end of this instruction for details.

GHIN Mobile App – Entering Hole-by-Hole Scores	
This instruction will use screen shots using GHIN mobile app, but the same steps apply on GHIN website	
Golfers without the current GHIN app can download the mobile app from either the iTunes App Store or Google Play. For golfers that already have the GHIN app, you will need to update their app.	
1) On the GHIN app, to logon you will need to enter your GHIN Number and Last Name.	
1) You will see a screen with your Name Handicap Index, etc. 2) To enter a score, click "Post Score". We recommend you do this on your first hole, so you can enter your scores hole-by-hole as you play.	

- 3) You will see 3 options
- **HOLE-BY-HOLE (select this one).** The USGA and RHGC strongly recommends you use “hole-by-hole” scoring as the software automatically determines your adjusted gross score. This also helps us compile hole-by-hole scores for the next time the Club needs to analyze hole indexes for handicap purposes.
 - HOLE-BY-HOLE WITH STATS
 - TOTAL SCORE

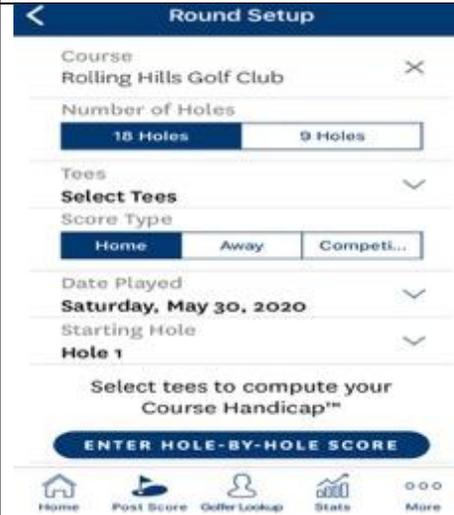


These instructions assume you selected HOLE-BY-HOLE.

- 4) You will then see a screen to Select Course.
- Recently Played Courses will show up if you have used App before, and if “Rolling Hills Golf Club” is already listed select it.
- Otherwise you can use Search feature to find the course make sure to select correct Rolling Hills Golf Club, Houston, Texas, USA



- 5) A screen “Round Setup” will appear. Here you select the
- Number of Holes (Select “18 Holes” or “9 Holes”)
 - Score Type (Select “Home” if playing RHGC)
 - Tees (drop down). Select tees playing (eg Blue, White, etc)
 - Date Played
 - Starting Hole (drop down)
 - Click “ENTER HOLE-BY-HOLE SCORE”



- 6) A screen will appear to enter your scores. You simply enter your gross score by hole, and click done.



In this example scored 5 on Hole 1, and system automatically calculated “Adj. Score” for handicap purposes as 5.

Do not “Post Score” you will do this at end. Just keep App open and continue to enter your scores



To continue example,

Hole 2 scored a 9, and the system automatically calculated 8 as “Adj. Score” since net double bogey is maximum score for handicap purposes



7) At the end of round, you can click Post Score.

Double check to make sure they are correct, then click post score.

Note that your adjusted gross score is calculated automatically. In the example, the gross score is 88 and adjusted gross score is 85 (43 on the front and 45 on the back So 85 will be posted).



8) Once you have posted score, a screen with your score posted, Handicap differential for round, and stats will be appear.

And you can also View Score History.





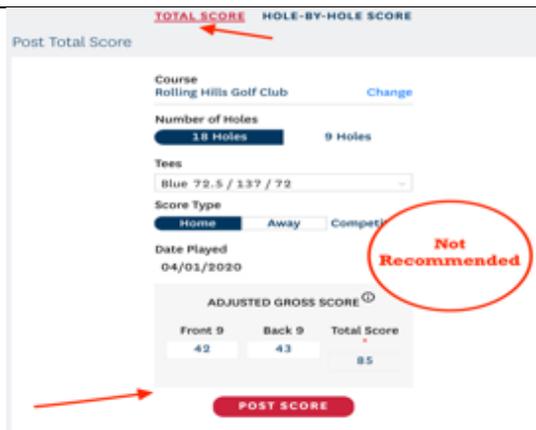
9) As a reminder, per the Handicap Policy, “Any errors or omissions a players scoring record should immediately be brought to the attention of Handicap Committee for their review and correction, if needed”.

GHIN Mobile App – “Total Score Option”

Although not recommended you can also enter your grand total Adjusted Gross Score.

1) To enter your using this option, you would have to manually track your gross score hole by hole and then adjust manually your “Adj. score” by hole based on maximum net double bogey for handicap purposes.

2) For example, for the above score, a front 9 adjusted score 43 and back 9 score 42 or 85 would be entered.

Course Handicap

- 1) Handicap indexes are being daily according to the newly introduced World Handicap System. To find your actual Course Handicap use the “CH Calculator” tab and select the tees you play from, in the above example it is Blue.
- 2) Select course handicap calculator tab, make sure course is correct, add names, and select tee box.

Some additional information....

“Score Types”

With the roll-out of WHS in January 2020, scores are identified with the letter designations below in your scoring record. These can be used to help identify the format of play, where a round was played and other details about the round.

H = Home (when you play Rolling Hills)

A = Away (when you play another course)

C = Competition (currently just used for all RGHC sanctioned events, when scores are entered for player) *

Not used by Player

N = Combined Nine Hole (done by system)

P = Penalty (used by Handicap Committee)

E = Exceptional (done by system)

M = Manually adjusted handicap index (used by Handicap Committee)

Note: for 2019 Scores, the previous letter designations still stand in the GHIN historical records. Home(H), Away(A), Penalty(P) and Manually adjusted index (M) stayed the same. These were different in 2019...

T = Tournament (now C in 2020), C = Combined Nine Hole (now N in 2020)
