# Handicap Committee Update July 12, 2020 Board Meeting

#### 1. Committee Actions

# 1.1 Missed Score Postings

- New process.
- Starting with week of "Sun May 31 to Sat June 6", on Mondays a new "Missed Score Postings Report" is sent out directly from ForeTees
- Allows weekend golfers extra day (due to interface) to post score after day of play
- Template used to explain policy and request member response why score not posted. After researching, Penalty "P" scores entered following Monday if not resolved
- Same process repeated weekly. See recap below

Once we have equipment budgeted/funded, we can install in Clubhouse area which will allow members more flexibility for score entry (including entering for other players. (Deferred to post COVID, when we can safely share screens)

# Exhibit 1 – Learnings during Research

#### **ForeTees**

- **No Post (NP) Box**: Option in ForeTees to check "No Post" box on tee time for non-acceptable rounds for handicap purposes. HC uses this feature to update ForeTees based on responses received.
- **30 day interface window**: During the research of the backlogged missing scores for Jan-Mar, we learned ForeTees daily "automated" download only pulls down scores from GHIN entered for the past 30 days. This caused some issues and peer review was probably pulling some false positives. Thankfully, ForeTees Corp Admin contacts were able to run the interface manually.
- Individual 9-hole scores not passed from GHIN: Foretees is still using the "Legacy API" which means during daily interface GHIN doesn't pass 9-holes to ForeTees until combined. GHIN is still supporting this API through October and COVID is the reason why they haven't been able to convert over any sooner. As a result, we will not report on missed individual 9-hole postings.
- "OTH" and "SCR" tee times. Since the change to WHS, the code that ForeTees wrote to leave "OTH" and "SCR" tee times off the Missed Postings Report is not working. We have to manually check it off as "No Post" or it shows up on Missed Posting Report.

#### **GHIN**

- Playing Conditions Calculation (PCC): Automated GHIN calculation, if actual scores are abnormally high or low versus expected scores on a given day. There were days where PCC kicked in for 2020 (all -1).
  - o Feb 20
  - o Mar 20, 22
  - o Jun 16, 24
  - o July 6, 9, 10
- **USGA TM did not pass hole-by- hole scores to GHIN**. We learned through research that hole-by-hole scores from USGA TM were not being pushed to GHIN during the interface; only total adjusted scores. As a result, some scores were not factored into the GHIN daily PCC process.
  - Example, Mar 20 weekend group (uses USGA TM App) event with 52 players, we did not see any PCC adj. in GHIN for these players. Why? USGA confirmed there was an integration issue with the USGA Course Rating System (CRS) system so TM couldn't pull the course info into TM.

This was resolved in July.
