Handicap Corner

Upcoming 2021 GHIN Digital Profile Requirement

Beginning in early January 2021, in order to post scores using the suite of GHIN products (GHIN.com & GHIN mobile app), each member with an active GHIN handicap number will need to register themselves for a 'GHIN Digital Profile'. In order to create a digital profile, a golfer must have a valid, unique email address in their GHIN account before January 2021. More information will be forthcoming on this requirement, but please review the attached list of Frequently Asked Questions for initial projection of what to expect in January. Click <u>here</u> to access the GHIN Digital Profile FAQs document.

To avoid any disruptions, RHGC has ensured that each active GHIN member has an email in their GHIN account. The RHGC handicap director (rhgchandicaps@gmail.com) has been diligently updating GHIN with all the required information over the past couple of weeks and adding missing emails in GHIN using available email addresses (e.g. from USGA TM). The GHIN email address is where more information will be sent to you in January by the GHIN system to establish your GHIN Digital Profile. So be on the lookout for these emails.

Score Posting for Minors (12 y/o and under) when Digital Profile launches

In tandem with the GHIN Digital Profile release, the ability to post scores and communicate with Minors (12 years old or under) will also be changing. Golfers designated as Minors will not be able to provide an email address, create a digital profile, or directly access GHIN Golfer Products (GHIN Mobile App, GHIN.com, GHIN Kiosks). Instead, their profile must be linked to a Guardian (19+ years old) who can then access the golfer products and post on their behalf. A Minor is defined as a golfer who is under 13 years of age per the date of birth in their GHIN golfer profile.

A new Guardian Management field has been introduced within GHIN to link a guardian to each minor before digital profiles are introduced in January 2021. Click <u>here</u> to access the Minor/Guardian FAQ's document.

For RHGC, this has been done, the guardian will be the RHGC primary member parent associated with the Minor in their family membership.

Grounds

The grass is nearing dormancy and this is the time of year that golf carts can do a lot of damage to the grass. As a reminder, please adhere to the below cart etiquette.

- Golf carts should not be driven within 30 feet of the greens
- Golf carts should not be driven between green-side bunkers and the green (hole 2-3-13-14)
- Golf carts should not be driven on tee boxes and collars
- Golf carts should not be driven into water penalty areas (3-4-12-13-15-16)
- Wooden barriers are used to direct traffic. Do not driven over them or move them.
- Where grounds are saturated due to irrigation issues, or rain, do your best to avoid driving over these areas as it can quickly damage the grass
- When practical, drive on cart paths and not the grass
- If driving on grass, stick to the fairway and minimize driving in the rough
