- Foretees issues : worked directly with Foretees tech support to fix some lingering issues impacting missed scores process. CLOSED
 - o OTH/SCR and No Post (NP)
 - 9H default for PM 9H tee time blocks
- **GHIN Kiosks:** Deferred to post COVID, when we can safely share screens. Received link to RHGC GHIN Kiosk set-up by USGA <u>https://kiosk.usga.org/x4d8q9</u>. Can install in Clubhouse area, etc to allow members flexibility for score entry (incl for other players). In 2021 Budget. **ON HOLD.**
- Proposal for Membership Process: Draft Proposal sent to Membership to add GHIN to process upfront for GHIN primary members. In prior meeting Membership reported these proposed changes to membership form/process were accepted however a decision was made to implement these changes with 2022 membership drive. DEFERERED to 2022 Membership Process.
