Handicap Corner

For members playing in the 2022 Match Play Events starting soon (Singles, Flighted, or Team), please review and adhere to the following regarding entering scores for your Match Play rounds.

Booking in ForeTees

Tee times must be booked as "REG" and all match play matches must be played as 18-hole rounds, not two separate 9-hole rounds.

Use of Golf Genius for hole-by-hole Scoring

All Match Play rounds should be scored using the Golf Genius (GG) application. In the event there are technical issues, players should use hardcopy scorecard. At the conclusion of round, all players must sign scorecard and attach scanned copy when reporting match result.

All holes should be scored in the following fashion: All holes should have an actual score entered for each player which reflects the actual score made during the match play round until the match is over. Once a player wins the hole there should not be any additional strokes made by the opponent after the stroke that resulted in losing the hole. In this case enter "most likely score". For example, enter X6 if most likely score is 6. The "X" by itself should not be used to enter any scores.

If your match ends before the completion of all 18 holes, leave the remaining holes not played with "no score/blank". If a match has been conceded or forfeited an email must be sent to 2022 Match Play Coordinator.

<u>Immediately After Match – Validate Scores in GG App</u> and Report Result

After the match is over, and before you leave the course, players in the match should review together the hole-by-scores entered in GG app for accuracy.

One player from match must email results to <u>Handicap Director</u> & <u>2022 Match Play Coordinator</u> with:

- Date of match
- Singles, Flighted or Team
- Name of Winner and result

For example "March 1, Singles, John Doe 5&4"

Do not enter any scores into GHIN, the Handicap Director will push scores from GG to GHIN after review. These scores will be denoted as score type "C" Competition in GHIN.

Disputes

Disputes should be handled during the round where possible by the players involved, with reference to the Rules of Golf 20.1b. If no agreement is reached, the matter should be promptly reported to 2022 Match Play Coordinator, who will review with Match Play Committee. Their decisions are final and binding. Where a match is played and concluded and players return to the clubhouse and report results, the match results remain as agreed at that time. This includes situations where there is a later dispute as to one player utilizing an incorrect handicap or where a rules infraction is recognized at a later time.

Jpdate on Tree Plantation

We have been informed by Gardening that the tree plantation project is now complete. This project is part of a greater Company green initiative program and not something the Golf Club requested. Although the plantations are within the boundary of the area of the golf course, they have for the most part been planted in areas that sit outside the boundary that defines the actual golf course which our greenkeeping and maintenance group maintain.

However, the plantations have and will transform the playability of the golf course both today and in the future. With this in mind, we have begun working on short, medium and long-term plans to manage these plantations going forward.

From a playability perspective, the initial short-term solution was to define all these areas as no play zones with a free drop as reflected in our communication to all members during the month of January. Although, this is a shortterm solution and all these areas will remain no play zones going forward, this local rule is temporary. The medium term plan will be to stake all these areas with consideration given to the appropriate stake to apply for each area.

Raking Bunkers and Golf Etiquette

RHGC Board is seeking cooperation from all members regarding the proper etiquette to rake bunkers. Unfortunately, the current etiquette of some members is just not good enough.

We realize that many members, because of the COVID relief rules, may have gotten out of the habit of raking bunkers. Please remember it is your responsibility to rake any bunker after you have entered it. Raking bunkers is part of the RHGC Code of Conduct. As such, continued and flagrant disregard for not raking bunkers can lead to penalty strokes being applied and ultimately a suspension of privileges.

Goldsworthy Win RHCC Handicap Tournament

Doug Mitchell and Julia Goldsworthy emerged from a field of 32 men and 16 women golfers in Dhahran to become the 1991-92 Handicap Champions at Rolling Hills Country Club. The single-elimination, match-play tournament began last fall.

"I've never been this close to winning it before," said Mitchell, who noted that the play-offs went more quickly this year. Past events were double-elimination, requiring more matches.

Mitchell, a 10-handicapper, said it vas "tough going" in most of his matches because he had to give away shots to competitors with higher handicaps. Even though he was evenly matched with runner-up Andy Poulton in the

final game, they both ran into difficulty. A strong wind on the East course blew many shots off course forcing them to "wade" in the water several times

Goldsworthy felt she was in control of her game throughout most of her matches. Saying her game has been strong, she added "I was playing well, especially in the match with Lynn. I had to give her 16 shots, but I actually beat her with three holes to go." Lynn McIntyre took the runner-up award.

Joe Fugere, tournament director for the event, said the handicap awards will be presented along with other event prizes at the evening function following the annual CEO Cup in February. - A. S.
