Revised RHGC Code of Conduct

Quick Quiz......Imagine you're about to score the best round of your life, or you're in contention to win your flight in a Monthly Medal; you're playing the 18th, and your tee shot lands in an unrepaired divot or more commonly, a footprint within a bunker; you score a triple bogey from that position.

Can we describe your mood as (1) Happy, or (2) Angry?

The answer is (2), you're angry, and you're cursing the player who could not be bothered to repair the damage.

Sadly, the condition of Rolling Hills has been deteriorating as a consequence of some unthoughtful players; scores are being affected, resources are being diverted from course improvements, and previous communications to address this behavior have been ignored.

We realize that education and equipment are important factors to help improve the situation; and we will continue to provide communications to address this issue and to help educate our membership. We have also requested more bunker rakes from Recreation.

In order to further address the problem regarding unraked bunkers, the RHGC Board has voted unanimously to implement a new measure by amending the RHGC Code of Conduct, specifically on page 2, paragraph 5 which states, "If a player is deemed to have failed, in whole or in part, to rake a bunker, the entire playing group shall be held responsible; therefore, all players will face warning and/or sanction by the RHGC Disciplinary Committee and/or the RHGC Tournament Committee."

In simple terms, you must work with your playing partners to ensure all bunkers are raked after use i.e., all footprints and ball impact marks are repaired.

In summary: Ensure all bunkers are raked correctly after a player in your group has taken a stroke; and instruct players to rake bunkers they have not raked.

Members are expected to report players who refuse to repair bunkers, immediately after the event, or at the conclusion of the round to rhgcdisciplinarycommittee@gmail.com in General play, alternatively, inform the RHGC Tournament Committee in Tournament play.

The Code of Conduct applies to all players when the course is being used. Please read it and understand what you need to do to help protect and improve the course. Go to https://www.arabiangolf.net/codeofconduct to read the revised (June 2022) Code of Conduct.
