# SAFETY NOTICE

A RHGC member was recently reported in a safety observation for cutting across the upper parking lot through the parking spaces in a golf cart, narrowly avoiding a collision with a car driving down the same lane. Members are reminded that golf cart owners must follow the same rules of the road as cars regardless of whether you are in the RHGC parking lot or on the road in the camp. Golf carts offer little protection as compared to a passenger vehicle, and the cart driver or passenger can be seriously injured or even killed in a collision.

In order to reduce the amount of golf cart traffic in the upper parking area, the chains preventing access to the cart path behind Chilis and the lower cart sheds will be left open. Note that the other chain mounted on two removable posts between the lower parking and the Chilis loading dock should always be left in place to prevent vehicular traffic from entering the golf course.

Members can help keep RHGC safe by using good driving practices and being aware of your surroundings no matter what type of vehicle you are driving on the road or in a parking area.


# Handicap Corner
