

HANDICAP CORNER

Want to Establish a Handicap Index?

You purchased your first set of clubs, and you have been hitting balls on the practice range or perhaps on a golf simulator. Now, you are eager to join your friends on the course and have a fair game. This is a common pathway for new golfers. However, to make it fair, you will need to get a Handicap Index®, which allows for an adjustment based upon each player's ability. *Establishing a Handicap Index allows all golfers to compete in a fair and equitable manner.*

But how do you go about getting one? You have to be a member of an authorized golf club, the good news is **Rolling Hills Golf Club** is an authorized type 1 golf club that operates under bylaws with committees (including a Handicap Committee) to supervise golf activities, provide peer review and maintain the integrity of the World Handicap SystemTM, and is authorized to issue and maintain handicap indexes for its members.

- 1. So, if you are a member at RHGC, all you just have to is ask to be setup in GHIN handicap system by contacting Handicap Director at rhgchandicaps@gmail.com.
- 2. Once you obtain a GHIN #, you just need to play and post scores from a total of 54 holes, made up of any combination of 9 or 18-hole rounds, and you will have a Handicap Index the very next day!
- 3. With that said, there are a few things to keep in mind while starting out:
 - Only scores made at courses with a valid Course Rating[™] and Slope Rating[®] are acceptable for handicap purposes. Nearly all courses around the world are rated.
 - The maximum hole score for handicap purposes during your first three rounds is limited to Par + 5. After that, your maximum hole score becomes a <u>Net Double Bogey</u>, equal to Double Bogey PLUS any handicap strokes you receive based on your Course HandicapTM. To make it easy, we recommend posting your scores using the hole-by-hole option, which will allow this adjustment to take place automatically!
 - For a nine-hole score to be acceptable, you must play at least 7 holes and to post an 18-hole score, at least 14 holes must be played. The score for the un-played holes? Par PLUS any handicap strokes you receive based on your <u>Course Handicap</u>.
 - Match play scores are also acceptable! When a stroke is conceded or you don't hole out when the format allows, you record your most likely score = the number of strokes already taken + number of strokes you would most likely require to complete the hole.
 - While establishing and maintaining a Handicap Index, it is important to adhere to the <u>Rules of Golf</u> and <u>Rules of Handicapping</u> to ensure accuracy.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP October 21 & 22, 2022

The 2022 Club Championship will be held on October 21 & 22. The qualifying rounds will be held on the 21st and the Championship round will be on the 22nd:

DAY 1 FOR BOTH MEN'S & LADIES' DIVISION: Stroke play, no handicaps (gross scores only), no flights. Cut is 50% of the field plus ties, based on gross score.

DAY 2 MEN'S DIVISION - Qualifying players only. Stroke play, no handicaps (gross scores only), previous day scores carry forward. These players shall be equally divided into 4 Flights (based on Handicap Index), and will compete for the overall Club Championship and as well for their assigned flight.

DAY 2 LADIES' DIVISION - Qualifying players only. Stroke play, no handicaps (gross scores only), previous day scores carry forward. These qualifying players will compete for the overall Club Championship as well as for the Ladies' Flight.

COMPETITION WINNERS - The Men's Club Champion will be the man returning the Low Gross score over 36 holes from the Championship Tees. The Women's Club Champion will be the woman returning the Low Gross score over 36 holes from the Championship Tees.


SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

57th Annual Saudi Aramco Invitational Tournament (SAIT) November 17 - 19 2022 Rolling Hills Golf Course, Dhahran, Saudi Arabia

Selected professional and amateur golfers ages 16+ will be considered for entry into the field. Entrants must have a WHS Handicap Index of 14.8 or lower. Initially, players in the WHS Handicap Index range from 8.2 and below will be competing in the Championship two-day low gross competition exclusively. Players with a WHS Handicap Index of 8.3 and above will compete in the Plate two-day low gross competition.

A player with a WHS Handicap Index of 8.3 or above may opt to play in the Championship competition at the time of registration, however, such player will compete for the Championship Competition exclusively. *The Committee reserves the right to changes these handicap cutoffs for Championship and Plate Divisions based on final field size.*
