- <u>GOLF CART REMOVAL</u>: All members who have a golf cart parked at RHGC by the ATM in the upper parking lot are required to remove it from this area <u>by December 4</u>. Carts may be returned to this area on December 18, after the ADT tournament has completed. Any golf cart still parked in this area on December 6 will be removed by Industrial Security.
- <u>TEMPORARY LOCAL RULE: BUNKERS:</u> Please be advised that due to the requirements to carry out maintenance work on all bunkers for the upcoming Asian Development Tour (ADT) event, the following temporary local rule will be in immediate effect starting **November 27.** All bunkers including the bunker faces and edges throughout the course are to be considered 'NO PLAY ZONES', therefore, similar to local rule for the tree plantation areas, all bunkers are to be treated as an <u>abnormal course condition</u>. Free relief must be taken if a ball comes to rest in a no play zone or the no play zone interferes with a player's intended stance. The nearest point of complete relief should be identified and a ball must be dropped in the relief area outside the no play zone. The relief area is one-club length from the nearest point of relief, not nearer to the hole. Players are <u>not permitted</u> to play in these no play zones (meaning <u>all</u> bunkers, bunker faces, and edges throughout the course).
- <u>SCORES FOR HANDICAP PURPOSES</u>: Please note that with immediate effect (Nov 27), and until the course returns to normal playing conditions after the ADT, <u>no scores should be entered for handicap purposes</u>.

2023 Membership Renewal

2023 Membership Renewal forms have now gone out to all primary members' personal email addresses registered with RHGC. Attached in the emails are forms that are prefilled with your membership information. If you have not received an email, please first check your spam/junk folder, then contact the RHGC Membership Director at RHGCMemberships@gmail.com.

The deadline for renewals without penalty is January 31, 2023. Renewals made on February 1 to February 28, 2023 will be subject to a 250 SAR late fee. Renewals from March 1 to December 31, 2023 will be treated as a new membership application and will be subject to the 500 SAR initiation fee. You will also lose your place on the cart shed waiting list.

Cart shed holders must renew by January 31, 2023. Failure to renew your membership will result in your cart shed being reassigned to the next member on the cart shed waiting list.



2023 Community Championship



Golf will once again be apart of the 2023 Community Championships. In order to compete you must register for it via the myCommunity app. RHGC cannot supply any support on using the app or registering for the event. Please follow up with Community Services with regards to the app or registration. Registration closes on December 8.

Like last year, the tournament will be a low gross tournament. Qualifying tournaments for adult men and women divisions will be the December 2022 and the January 2023 medals. The lowest gross scores from one of these events will be used as the qualifying score. If you wish to participate in the finals of the Community Championships, you must compete in either the December or January medals. At this point we have not been told how many qualifiers that Dhahran will have for the Finals. The Finals will take place the first week in March.
