


President's Message

- Monday through Saturday: 5:30am 10:00pm


The intent is to keep the Proshop "AS IS" during Ramadan:



April 26 & 27, 2024

The President's Cup is a two-day event, with teams of 2 golfers. Day 1 is a qualifying day, which top 50% plus ties proceeding to Day 2 (President's Team proceeds to Day 2 regardless of placing).

Day 1:

- 75% handicap, Stableford, each golfer plays own ball
- Best ball of the two in the Team is counted each hole
- Skill prizes for Nearest to Pin on Par-3s, Longest drive for Men/Ladies as well as closest to President's drive on Hole #1

Day 2:

- 75% handicap of the average of the team.
- Stableford, Alternating shots.
- 1 Player will tee off the Odd tees and the other will tee off the Even tees, with alternating shots until the ball is holed

EID ECLECTIC April 9th - 14th



- Maximum 6 Rounds
 - o Men White Tees
 - o Ladies Red Tees
- Declare to your playing partners before you begin the round that it will be a tournament round that will count towards the Eclectic Score.
- For a round to count towards your eclectic score, you must complete at least 14 of 18 holes of the round. In other words, maximum of 4 "X outs" per round.
- You may only play 1 tournament round per day
- Tournament cards will be available to all who sign up. There will be one card for each day. These will be at the Starters Shack. Only official tournament cards will be accepted.
- Sign your card and have your player partner initial the card once the round is completed and place it in the green tournament score box to be located at the Starter.
 - All cards will be picked up at 8pm each day.
 - Cards for that day will not be accepted after 8pm that day.
- The committee will be entering your daily scores into Golf Genius.
 You can track your progress via the Leaderboard on the app.

Spring Renovations

"The annual spring renovations of the golf course will take place during the month of March, as a result:

- The Back 9 will be closed from March 10th to 13th (Sunday to Wednesday inclusively), and
- The Front 9 will be closed from March 17th-20th (Sunday to Wednesday inclusively).

A communication will be sent to all members to confirm the above closer to the time."

During the two weeks the golf course is closed for the spring renovations the grounds team led by our superintendent Jason Sexton, have be working very hard to execute some critical activities for the betterment of the course, as explained by Jason below:

Turf Management and the control of thatch which is a layer of organic material that accumulates at the soil surface. An excessive thatch layer has negative consequences resulting in the decrease of gas exchange in the soil, impacting water infiltration into the soil that creates excessive moisture at the soil surface promoting disease and scalping.

The main tools used to combat thatch are Verticutting and Core Aeration. These processes physically removes the organic material that is from the thatch layer. The photos below from these renovations illustrate just how much of this material was "choking out" the system.



Core aerification has the added benefit of relieving soil compaction created by golf carts, maintenance equipment and foot traffic. Compacted soil decreases gas exchange and water infiltration in the turf making core aerification an essential part of the turf management process.

The frequency and timing of these practices is determined by soil type, turf type, amount of play, climate, available equipment, budgets etc. Although this process can be disruptive, any inconvenience caused by these practices greatly improve course conditioning and protects it from disease ensuring making any inconvenience more than worth it.

SIMPLE TIPS TO TO PLAYING THE FLOP/LOB SHOT ...

Often the ball comes to rest near the target with very little green to work with...
The high flop shot is an effective way to stop the ball quickly and get it close...

L. Assess The Situation...

Firstly check the Lie is suitable ideally sitting up and not on a tightly mown area...

Get a closer look at the green and where the flag is, pick a spot where you want the ball to land...



2. Club Selection

Choose your most lofted or angled club (56/60 degree)



Swing Technique

"Lay the club face open before the hold is established... Hands are behind the club face... Ball position forwards... Weight favor's the trail foot...



4. Swing Technique

Make a full committed swing holding the club face open through impact... The ball will travel almost vertically so stopping dead...



Ladies Roll Up Class

Every Thursday moring 9-10am for beginner and intermediate golfers. All equipemnt is supplied and instruction covers all skills to get one out on the course. Cost is 90 SAR per person, per class with sign-up at the Pro Shop.

Golf in a Week
