#### SIMPLE TIPS TO LAG PUTTS

Often the ball comes to rest a distance from the green. The ground is flat and consistent making the putter a good alternative to chipping.

The saying goes "A bad putt usually finishes closer than a bad chip shot."

1. Assess The Situation

Firstly, check that the lie is suitable ideally sitting up with no obstructions. For severe slopes, get a closer look at the green and where the flag is to determine where you don't want your next putt. Use positive and achievable goals. For example, imagine a circle around the hole the size of a trash can.

2. The Address/Starting Position


Check that the putter is at right angles to your intended line by picking a spot in front of the ball. Avoid tension. Soft hands will allow the use of the wrists creating a second leaver for a more short and controlled putting stroke.

3. Swing Technique

Use both the wrists and shoulders. This will encourage a more centered contact. The ball will roll out better thus improving distance control. The putter is the most important club to strike correctly.
